An act relating to the preemption of local occupational licensing; amending s. 163.211, F.S.; extending the date on which certain local government occupational licensing requirements expire; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 163.211, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
 - 163.211 Licensing of occupations preempted to state.-
- (2) PREEMPTION OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING TO THE STATE.—The licensing of occupations is expressly preempted to the state, and this section supersedes any local government licensing requirement of occupations with the exception of the following:
- (a) Any local government that imposed licenses on occupations before January 1, 2021. However, any such local government licensing of occupations expires on <u>July 1, 2024</u> July 1, 2023.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
